METHODOLOGY

The study was conducted in a randomized controlled trial design, involving 100 participants. The participants were randomly assigned to two groups: the intervention group and the control group. The intervention group received the intervention, while the control group received a placebo. The study was conducted over a period of 12 weeks.

The WHO definition of a disease was used to determine the eligibility criteria for the study. The inclusion criteria were: (1) participants who were aged 18 years and above, (2) participants who were healthy and free from any chronic diseases, (3) participants who were willing to participate in the study. The exclusion criteria were: (1) participants who were pregnant or breastfeeding, (2) participants who were taking any medication that might interfere with the study, (3) participants who had any other condition that might affect the results of the study.
